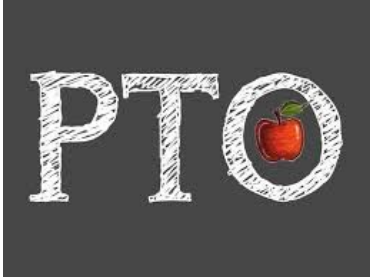

Fueling bodies and minds is crucial regardless of where the learning occurs! DCSD Nutrition Services is providing weekly meal bags, available by pre-order only and curbside pickup, for all students enrolled at participating sites during eLearning and hybrid learning. Weekly meal bags for 100% eLearners contain 5 breakfast meals and 5 lunch meals, including fruits/veggies and milk for each meal. Weekly meal bags for Hybrid learners will contain 5 breakfast and 3 lunches. A lunch only bag will be available for Hybrid learners as well with lunches.
